POLICY FOR EVALUATION OF DEGREE CREDENTIALS FROM NON-U.S. INSTITUTIONS

The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools criteria requirements for faculty academic

preparation include verification that the highest earned degree at a non-U.S. institution is comparable to a

degree earned at a regionally accredited institution within the United States. The following procedure will

enable TCU to obtain the specific required documentation.

1. Before recommending the appointment of any faculty candidate (full-time, part-time or adjunct

faculty) whose highest earned degree is from a non-U.S. institution, the academic dean will

obtain transcripts or other appropriate credentials from the non-U.S. institution. A contract will

not be issued prior to receipt of the degree evaluation.

2. The Dean's Office will use an approved external agency (list of agencies maintained in Provost's

Office) to evaluate the authenticity of both the non-U.S. institution and the transcript/credentials.

3. The academic dean will submit the degree certification and transcript, along with the formal

recommendation for appointment of the faculty candidate, to the Vice Chancellor for Academic

Affairs. The degree certification and transcript will be maintained in the official academic

credential file for that faculty member.
