Supporting EVIDENCE OR JUSTIFICATION:

Nevertheless, a shorter, non-certification/licensure track is still needed in counseling, as school counseling and clinical mental health counseling require 48 hours and 60 hours, respectively. Therefore, we wish to convert this program to a general counseling degree.
