   Page 43 of the catalog states double degrees must (2<sup>nd</sup> bullet) "fulfill all specific major…degree requirements…" We propose adding this line to clarify for students that double degrees in our college still require a minor. For double majors, the second major fulfills the minor requirement, but a double degree requires a minor as part of the free-standing degree. We see this as a key difference between a double degree and a double major. We have systems in place to advise these students to help them find the best fit between the double major and double degree.
