1. What is the justification for the change(s) requested?
 Supply chain graduates are increasingly expected to be able to apply their knowledge to deliver solutions to ambiguous business problems. The supply chain curriculum is being changed such that all students will have taken the core major classes (INSC 40303, INSC 40313, INSC 40323) prior to enrolling in INSC 40353 and INSC 40343. INSC 40353 Global Supply Chain Management will have students apply their supply chain knowledge to address global case problems. INSC 40343 Supply Chain Strategy will further extend this by covering applications to real-world strategic business problems. This sequence means that INSC 40353 must now be a required course.


3. **Faculty Resources:** How will the unit provide faculty support for this change and any other impact this change may have on other current departmental listings.
