 - 1) Faculty teaching EDUC 20003 have shared that course content is pertinent to those seeking teacher certification. Since the educational studies minor does not lead to teacher certification, and does not attract students who are interested in pursuing teacher certification, the course is not needed/relevant as a degree requirement. Instead, it is more relevant as a degree elective.
 - 2) In addition, content covered in EDUC 41113 is more relevant than EDUC 20003 to career aspirations of YAES majors, so it is being proposed as an educational studies minor requirement.
 - 3) The addition of EDUC 30103 provides educational studies minors who are specifically interested in the development of teenage youth with a more
