 With the relatively new unification of the Architectural Lighting Design, Interior Design, and Graphic Design programs, the Department wants to be able to offer more flexibility, including all Departmental offerings to our students. The Design Studies degree already exists as general-design degree. The faculty made the decision to revise it to broaden offerings and allow students to choose between the traditional graphic design-oriented option, or an emphasis in Architectural Lighting Design or to create a multidisciplinary design degree with a more entrepreneurial direction.
