 The Management Department currently teaches five courses that are part of Neeley’s core curriculum, more than any other department in Neeley. From a practical perspective, the change is being made to reduce the administrative burden carried by management. Pedagogically, the focus of this course will shift from a more philosophical, law school-oriented perspective to a more practical approach targeted toward individuals who will not be practicing lawyers, but instead will face legal and regulatory challenges in established and new ventures. As such, it makes sense for this course to be housed in the Entrepreneurship & Innovation Department.


2. If applicable, explain how the change(s) will affect the current program outcomes and assessment mechanisms.
