

# **Child Development Minor**

#### **Requirements**

The child development minor is a multidisciplinary program drawing upon the strengths of several colleges and disciplines.

Students wishing to earn the child development minor are required to take 18 hours of coursework. Courses must be selected from at least three different departments and may include the department of the student's major. No more than six hours may be taken from one department, and no more than three hours may be taken from Independent Studies and Special Topics courses combined. Case Studies in Child Development will be the only required course for students in the minor. Its interdisciplinary focus is designed to give students in the minor comprehensive insight into the issues of child development. Faculty are available within each of the departments to monitor availability and suitability of Special Topics courses and other special opportunities. Advising is available within the Child Development Program.

The KPICD Education Team has been working on updating the child development curriculum to better match how TBRI has developed over the years. We have made a slide show that shows the process and what it is currently and where we want to go. I have attached it. We have approval from the KPICD to move forward with everything and now I am seeking your approval.

I would love to talk with you about the plan, specifically about the items below:

- Associated requirements: We want to propose a required CHDV research and evaluation course that would be required for CHDV majors. If that course is approved, we wanted to know if it would be helpful to remove PSYC 30503 Research Methods in Psychology as an associated requirement for CHDV majors. If it's helpful to have fewer students trying to get into PSYC 30503, we can remove it from the associated requirements.
