The addition of THEA 11023 Diverse Voices is necessary to provide students with a course with DEI and CRES attributes. Changes made to other requirement categories are in an effort to accommodate the addition of Diverse Voices without increasing the number of required hours (84) and to give students more choices in shaping their THMU-BFA coursework. The reduction of 1 hour of Production Courses allows room for student choice in elective coursework. Students will still receive broad exposure to different production areas through THEA 30901 Theatre Production assignments as
