No credit may be transferred from a community college once 54 cumulative semester hours have been earned.

Students may take a course off campus during an academic semester so long as, using the Transfer Request Credit System, 1) it is preapproved -by a department/faculty the advisor, unit head and the Office of the Dean of Harris College, 2) all hours taken in that semester-totals no more than 18 hours, and 3) it does not interrupt the last 30 hours being taken at TCU.
