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1. What is the justification for the change(s) requested?

The program faculty are attempting to make the performance degrees more relevant to our graduates as they enter the profession. These changes accomplish two goals:

- 1. They provide some additional flexibility for students in choosing which version of counterpoint they wish to take to satisfy the degree requirements in music theory.
- 2. Exposes students to the world of music business and arts leadership, a critical base of knowledge that our students need.

Both changes can also be considered to make the degree more relevant to our students while also better preparing them for a career in the arts.

2. If applicable, explain how the change(s) will affect the current program outcomes and assessment mechanisms.

Current program outcomes will be improved by exposing students to critical music business concepts, which could lead to the student taking further courses in that sequence to achieve either the certificate or minor in Arts Leadership and Entrepreneurship offered by the College of Fine Arts.

Assessment will be largely unaffected as neither the modal counterpoint class nor the ALRE course are currently assessed in the program reviews.

3. Faculty Resources: How will the unit provide faculty support for this change and anyother impact this change may have on other current departmental listings.

We have consulted with the College of Fine Arts and they will be able to accommodate the additional students that will now be required to take the ARLE course. The change to the counterpoint requirement will not affect faculty resources.
