Requirements

The BA with a major in communication studies consists of 120 semester hours with 27 hours in communication studies, including the four required courses:

COMM10123 — Communicating Effectively (3 hours)

OI

COMM 10163 — Public Address (Honors) (3 hours)

COMM 20113 — Interpersonal Communication (3 hours)

COMM 20223 — Communication Theory (3 hours)

COMM 30163 — Organizational Communication (3 hours)

It is expected that these four courses will be completed within the first 18 hours of COMM coursework.

Note: Students must complete COMM 20113 and COMM 20223 with a combined GPA of 2.5 or higher to enroll in COMM 30163.

Additional requirements include the BA language requirement, a minor of 18 semester hours or a second major, plus core curriculum requirements.

1. What is the justification for the change(s) requested?

The Department of Communication Studies has offered both a BS and a BA degree plan options. Recent assessment efforts have demonstrated curricular and learning outcome overlap between the two plans. We believe students would be best served by a more efficient structure, and the remaining Bachelor of Science program is robust enough to accommodate departmental goals and objectives.

2. If applicable, explain how the change(s) will affect the current program outcomes and assessment mechanisms.

By dropping the BA degree plan options, the department will be able to more clearly assess learning objectives and outcomes in the major. Students currently pursuing the BA will be allowed to continue under their catalog requirements. We do not anticipate these changes to impact timely completion of their degrees. By focusing solely on the BS degree plan, we can continue to more efficiently plan, deliver, and assess our curriculum.
