The College of Education proposes to reduce the Generalist EC-6 with Bilingual Option to 126 hours. Proposed changes include:

1. Removing EDEC 30323 TESOL Methods, as there is a lot of overlap between this course and the required EDUC 50503 Foundations of Language Acquisition, which is tailored specifically to bilingual education majors certification needs (-3)
2. Decreasing the number of SPAN hours from 9 to 3 (-6)
3. Adding EDEC 20023 Math for Teachers of EC-6 and EDEC 20013 Science for Elementary Teachers (+6)
