

- Diversity is increasing. It is more ٠ challenging at highest ranks.
- TCU is following the national trend of ٠ increases in full time faculty on contracts instead of tenure-track.





The AddRan operating budget is 13% of the Academic Affairs (AA) budget; the college employs 22% of fulltime faculty at TCU; and delivers 26% of the student-credit hours on campus .

AddRan SCH per fulltime faculty is higher than the university average. AddRan maintains small classes by relying on adjunct instructors more than other colleges.

AddRan external research expenditures are 3% of the university total, and the college graduates 10% of the doctoral students on campus annually.

- ✓ "Power Five" 63 universities classified as Carnegie R1; Two universities classified as R2 TCU and Wake Forest
- R2 classification supports the Teacher Scholar model faculty are supported to teach and do research
- ✓ TCU is distinguished as one of only two universities in the country in a power five conference that authentically embraces the *Teacher Scholar* model
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
